

MAINLAND JR WRESTLING SCHOLARSHIP

Mainland Junior Wrestling (MJW) strives to provide quality wrestling for an affordable price to all children. While MJW fees are near the lowest fees in the state, still some families still can not afford the fees associated with participating. MJW will provide reduced fees and complete scholarships to wrestlers. The basis for awarding of the scholarships will be **need, community service** and **giving back to the sport**.

MJW is a volunteer run organization and some volunteer positions offer reduced or no fees for the time you put into the program. The manner, skills, and services that you can provide MJW should be outlined and attached to the application on additional pages. MJW prefers to not provide free access to wrestlers and views applications for partial payments request and/or volunteered in kind services more favorably.

Eligibility

- Be a resident of Linwood, Northfield, or Somers Point.
- Demonstrate active service to his or her family and community and a strong desire to give back to the sport.

Application Procedure

An applicant must include all of the following:

1. a completed application;
2. description of volunteer services provided to the club or offered. Club needs help running its snack bar, working the scorer table at matches, organizing apparel sales, etc.

Completed applications must be **submitted no later than December 15**. Applications will be reviewed by the MJW Board of Directors.
